Below is our standard Pallet Exchange Service.

NJFS only exchanges good for good

- Our clients will not accept substandard pallets when we ship out, so we cannot give credit for them. In some cases, carriers may be required to stack product off of bad pallets and onto good.
- We do not keep an inventory of bad or substandard pallets for exchange.

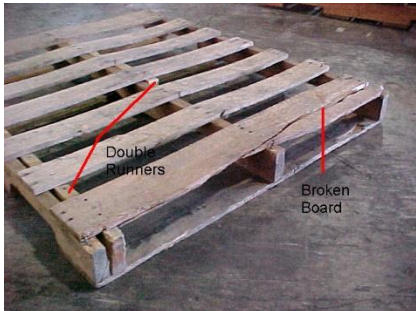
What is a good pallet?

- Must be a GMA four way entry pallet.
- No missing or broken boards or runners.
- No double runners, plugs or patches.
- No softwood pallets.
- Must be no obvious contamination or infestation (blood, oil, bugs, bird droppings, etc.). In extreme cases of contamination or suspected infestation, NJFS may not allow pallets in its facilities.

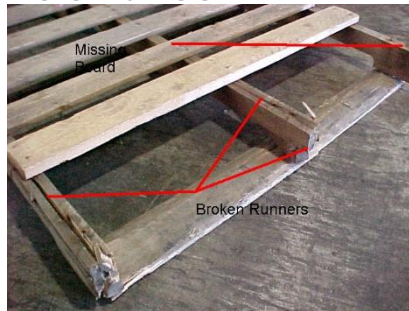
Sorting pallets

- Carriers are NOT permitted to use our loading docks to sort pallets. This ties up valuable dock and door space and is an injury risk in areas of heavy forklift traffic.

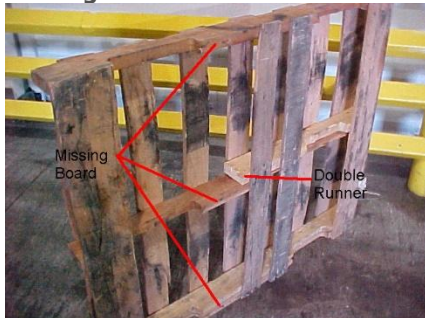
Broken Board and Double Runners



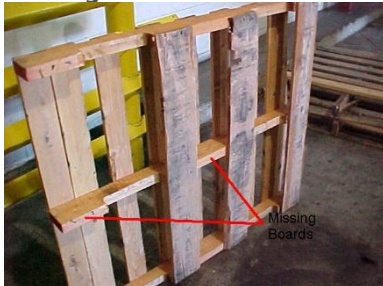
Broken Runners
